

**Juniper Hill Ladies Golf Club
Spring/March Meeting
March 13, 2012
Juniper Hill Golf Course**

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Co-Chair Billie Lee. (Co-Chair Kim Wooldridge was not in attendance)

22 members were present

Co-Chair Billie Lee welcomed all the Ladies. Billie briefly discussed the registration forms and explained that it was still necessary to write 2 checks (Late Swingers and Wednesday Day Ladies)

Copies of the Sec/Treasurer reports were in the process of being made so Kirk Schooley, PGA spoke to the ladies. Kirk reminded everyone that clinics would be starting at the end of March, Tuesdays would be held at Lakeview and Thursdays will be at Juniper. He also mentioned that 'Free Lesson Friday' would continue every Friday (after lunch) for ladies until the end of March.

Kirk also explained to the ladies that there had been a study done on the ladies scores, and the holes have been revised as per the 'hardest' holes. #14 is now the hardest hole, #4, 2nd; #12, 3rd; #5, 4th; etc. The score cards have been changed to reflect the new hdcp. It was also discussed that the course would be re-rated by the KGA-PGA later this spring.

Kirk also suggested that since the JHGA no longer has a Labor Day event that the Ladies and the Men plan to have a joint event.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Copies of the Secretary minutes were distributed and there was a motion by Susan Spoonamore to accept the minutes from the Fall/October meeting. Motion was seconded by Pam Rhodes.

Copies of the Treasurers report were distributed and read by the Treasurer, Barbara Reynolds. There was a motion by Glenda Wardrip to accept and was seconded by Trina Rhoads. Motion passed, all were in favor of the Secretary's and Treasurers reports.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Tournament Chair, Michele Brown was present and requested volunteers to help with her committee. The first event is April 7th, Season Opening Scramble, assigned teams. Lunch will be served at 11:30, scramble begins at 1:00.

The price of tournaments for the 2012 season will be \$5. (The Ladies Club Championship and Match Play will be \$10.) There will be an optional skins game offered and chip in pots will be available to those who wish to play. If the schedule says MOTT (make your own tee time). The date for the Ladies Club Championship is Aug. 11-12.

There will be a Ladies division for the City Championship again this year. There were issues last year because of the wide handicap range for the Championship flight. It was announced that issue will be remedied by having NET prizes available for the 2012 City Championship.

Michele also brought up that on Hole #15, slightly right area behind the green that has been GAR for many years, is no longer ground under repair and the ball must be played from the spot it lies (rock drains/ditch are red staked and same rules apply).

Our web site expert, Teresa Prather was not in attendance. It had been discussed at our fall meeting that she was going to change carriers to GODADDY.com but at the JHLGC board meeting, Teresa determined that there were too many issues to resolve so she changed to ONEPLUSONE.com. Our web site (JHLGC.org) is up and running and is very informative and looks great.

Sue Wood, Handicap Chair, asked for volunteers to help her with handicaps reports that come out on the 1st-15th of each month, just in case she could not be available. Michele Brown and Donna McNeil offered their help. We were also reminded that Hdcp fees should be paid before the end of April in order to keep current in the GHIN system.

The annual audit was conducted by Margaret Hanly on the JHLGC account in the fall. A letter was read by Barbara Reynolds, stating that the audit was complete and all records are current and that there were no discrepancies. Pam Rhodes made a motion to accept the audit report, Michele Brown seconded. Motion passed, all were in favor.

Donna McNeil gave a report on the chairs that was agreed upon in the fall meeting. Donna found a better deal, no shipping and the 50 chairs come with a dolly and chair truck for \$847. Colors were black and maroon. Black was the preferred color but maroon is also acceptable. Michele Brown made a motion to go forward and purchase the chairs, Dawn Redmon seconded. Motion passed, all were in favor.

NEW BUSINESS

At the fall meeting, it was determined that there was not a Ladies Club Championship plague. The treasurer suggested that we could spend no more than \$150 on a plague. After further discussion it was determined that we would list winners from 2000 to present. Karen Leibman made a motion to spend \$150 on the above, Sue Wood seconded. Motion passed, all were in favor.

The JHGA very generously gave the ladies and additional \$1,000 for helping the men during the Governor's Open which was a great success in 2011. It was discussed and agreed that the money will be used strictly for the Ladies Club Championship in August. Charlotte Nelson asked if a thank you note had been sent. (One had not but one was put in the mail the next day!)

Michele Brown brought up that the Greens Keepers Revenge tournament held in October raised \$1,750 for improvements for the golf course. A discussion ensued about the possibility of purchasing rectangle tables for the back room to replace the round ones that take up too much room. Most agreed that would be acceptable.

Being there was no further business, a motion was made by Barbara Terrell to adjourn and was seconded by Trina Rhoads. Meeting was adjourned.
