FALL MEETING

OCTOBER 8, 2013

The Juniper Hill Ladies Golf Club met on Tuesday, October 8, 2013. Fifteen (15) members were in attendance.

The meeting was called to order by Co-Chair Kim Wooldridge at 6:06 pm. Due to medical issues Donna McNeil (Co-Chair) was unable to attend. Other officers in attendance were Michele Brown, tournament chair and Barbara Reynolds, secretary/treasurer and Sue Wood, Handicap Chair.

Kim Wooldridge asked that the minutes be read from the spring meeting and there was a motion from Michele Brown and seconded by Aggie Hampton not to read the minutes from the March meeting. Motion carried.

Barbara Reynolds then proceeded to give a treasurer's report stating that there is a balance of \$2,411.12. \$1,000. of that balance is the money that the JHGA have given to the JHLGC for the 2014 Ladies Club Championship and is to be deposited into the Tournament Committees checking account in the spring of 2014. Shirley Rodgers made a motion to accept the Treasure's report and Aggie Hampton seconded. Motion carried.

Michele Brown gave a report on the Tournament Committee and an approximate balance of \$50 has been left in their account. Connie Page will turn in an official Treasure's report in the near future. Michele reported that we averaged 39 players for our w/e tournaments and had 78 play in the Ladies Club Championship. It was discussed that we should try harder next year to get more ladies to participate and maybe we could work out a deal with Kirk to get reduced green fees/cart fees for our ladies. The Juniper Cup was a great success and everyone who participated in the team event

expressed how much fun it was. The Juniper Cup will be offered for the 2014 season. It was agreed by all that the Tournament Committee did an excellent job on all events in the 2013 season and everyone appreciated all the efforts and hard work that Michele and her committee had done to make 2013 such a success.

Sue Wood gave a report for the Handicap Committee. She reported that there were 138 paid handicaps for the 2013 season. She suggested that we purchase a current handicap manual. It was offered by Michele that one could probably be downloaded from the KGA website or that we are entitled to a free copy each year. It was discussed that our numbers are declining but we are still the largest ladies league in the state of Kentucky and possibly in the United States.

Teresa Prather had no new information on the Website/newsletter except that if anyone had any suggestions or topics that needed to be discussed to let her know. It was noted on the exceptional job Teresa does on the newsletter and how all our ladies enjoy it. During the winter the newsletter will only be sent once a month.

New Business

Since there is \$1,411.12 left in the checking account, it was discussed that we should give back to the golf course through an improvement. It was discussed that it would be a better idea to form a committee to present options at our spring meeting. Michele Brown made a motion that a committee be formed to present suggestions for improvements and seconded by Sue Wood. Motion carried.

Shirley Rodgers noted that she will be looking over the By-laws this winter to see if changes are needed and will present her findings at the spring meeting.

Teresa Prather also brought up the discussion of how we can advertise our leagues and get more ladies involved. A member guest tournament was discussed but it was determined that our best solution was to get beginning golfers to join our leagues. Teresa will head a committee to help Kirk promote his clinics in order for our league to grow.
