Setup - Hand Position

Like the grip, hand position during the setup can change ball flight dramatically. Lower shots, higher shots, fades, draws etc. are all influenced by hand position.

When we speak of 'hand position' we are referring to the height of the hands at address. Otherwise explained, the distance of the golfer's hands from the golfer's body and their position from left to right relative to the center of the body. It is a good idea to experiment with different hand positions to see which positions result in what kind of shot for your swing.

Some general rules follow:

1. A forward press or moving of the hands ahead of the club head at address will lower the trajectory of a shot.
2. Moving the hands further away from the body or reaching out to the ball may create fades or slices.
3. Lifting the hands so your arms become more of a direct extension straight down the shaft of the club will allow the club to turn over more and therefore reduce slices, remove a fade or even create a draw or hook depending on other swing characteristics.

The best place to begin is a hand position that includes the following:

1. Hands hanging directly down from your shoulders.
2. Hands that are lined up even with the golf ball.
3. Hands that are not raised, but allow for a slight angle to be created in the wrists.

The rest is up to you - experimentation and practice to achieve the desired shot at the appropriate time.

The Governor's Open – September 5-7

Volunteers Needed

The 50th Governor's Open scheduled for September 5th-7th, 2014 is just around the corner. The Juniper Hill Golf Association does many wonderful things with the proceeds from this tournament. Besides giving to local charities, re-investing in the golf course, and supporting the local high school golf teams, they also donate \$1000 to our Juniper Hill Ladies Golf Association as a demonstration of appreciation for our support to the Governor's Open. The \$1000 is used to offset costs and support the Juniper Hill Ladies Club Championship, which will be held September 13th-14th.

Given the large number of participants this tournament would not be a success without your time and consideration for volunteering for the various jobs. Below is a list of jobs and the timeframes that are expected to be needed for each. The timeframes may change slightly depending on the final number of players. Please send an email to Donna McNeil at dmcneil0324@gmail.com or call [502.330.0015](tel:502.330.0015) and let her know what job and what time you are available to help. She will send out a confirmation email with instructions prior to Friday, September 5th.

Back Room Clean Up: Kirk has assured me that this group is not needed this year but I would prefer that if I can get about 4 ladies to help make sure the back room is cleaned as well as can be expected prior to Friday, September 5th.

Friday Cart Return/Clean Out: 2 volunteers are needed for about 45 minutes from 12:15 to 1:00.

Friday Evening Desserts: Karen Jones will coordinate. Need a group of ladies to set up and make sure there are desserts kept on the self-serve tables. Time is usually 5:30 to 8:00.

Drink Stations are located beside the number 8 tee on the front and the number 14 tee on the back.

1 volunteer is needed to work with Robin Johnston all three days to make sure each station is stocked and has enough ice.

For Friday, the times are 8:00 to 1:00 for the morning session and 1:00 to 6:00 for the afternoon session.

For Saturday and Sunday, the times are 8:30 to about 5:30 for the front station and 9:00 to 6 for the back stations. Volunteers must be at least 21 on Friday and Saturday because of the beer sales.

Spotters are needed as follows: Hole # 2 (Saturday and Sunday) from 12:30 to 4:00. Spotter on Hole #13 will work with the volunteers at the drink station on #14 to let them know when the fairways on each hole is cleared so that the next group can hit their tee shots. Times needed are from 8:30 to about 5:30. Hole # 17 for the shootout (Saturday and Sunday) from 9:00 to 7:00.

Watch Pro Shop Front Door during initial tee shots. Hole #1 (Saturday and Sunday) from 7:30 to 9:30 and from 12:00 to 2:00.

Scoreboard: I have asked someone to coordinate the scoreboard. If you are interested in helping, please send me an email or call. Friday scorecards are complicated because you count the 3 lowest best ball scores and the professionals entire score. For Saturday and Sunday, help will be needed from 12:30 to 2:00 and then 5:00 to 7:30.

Electronic Scoreboard: We are going to try and have the electronic scoreboard again this year on **SUNDAY** only. If you wish to help with this, you may need to walk Juniper with a 4-some. There probably won't be enough carts. You will be given a group of Professionals or Championship players and will need to communicate back to a coordinator (Mark Wash) their hole-by-hole scores.

Answer: No. Sand is a loose impediment on the putting green, but not elsewhere [Definition of "Loose Impediments"]. The penalty for brushing sand off the fringe is two strokes (loss of hole in match play) for a breach of Rule 13-2.

DON'T FORGET – Be good to our course; replace divots, rake bunkers and repair ball marks.
