SPRING MEETING

MARCH 10, 2015

The Juniper Hill Ladies Golf Club met on Tuesday, March 10th 2015. Forty-Four (44) members were in attendance.

The meeting was called to order by Co-Chair Aggie Hampton at 6:00 pm. Aggie introduced the 2015 officers and all were in attendance. They are:

First on the agenda, Kirk Schooley, Juniper Hill PGA Professional, addressed the meeting. He discussed the upcoming clinics in April which will start Tuesday April 14th at Lakeview, April 16th at Juniper and will continue for 3 weeks on that rotation. There also will be a rules seminar held by Lisa Goins on March 31st, at 7:00 pm at Juniper Hill. All were urged to attend. The last week of April, Kirk will be promoting golf at the Frankfort City schools in hopes of getting more students interested. Capital Day School has a golf awareness program that is held on Friday evenings and will begin the end of April. Kirk asked that if anyone would like to help with these programs, their assistance would be very much appreciated.

Kirk also discussed the changes in tournament play for the upcoming season in that ladies with 40 and up handicaps and new golfers were encouraged to play in the JHLGC tournaments and that there would be a 9 hole division for this purpose.

Kirk explained that there are plans in the works to extend the #5 green and more ladies tee boxes will be leveled and made larger in the 2015 season. He also would like to see the ladies play in a mixed scramble in the Labor Day tournament to be held in September.

OLD BUSINESS

The Secretaries minutes from the fall meeting held on October 7, 2014 were made available to all the members attending the meeting. It was motioned by Michele Brown that the minutes not be read, and was seconded by Pam Rhodes. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was also available in hard copy form and the treasurer gave a brief report on the activity of the club account with only 2 checks written for the year of 2015, one for the KGA membership dues and the other for the purchase of the much needed CPU. The balance is \$564.90.

Shirley Rodgers introduced and discussed the changes that will be made to the By-Laws for the upcoming season. The additions are that email votes will be allowed and that the individual league rules will be known as Operational Guidelines and the JHLGC will have By-laws. Also, to be changed is that the final meeting of the season will be held directly after the final event (usually Haunting on the Hill) so that a separate meeting does not have to be held in October. A motion was made to accept and adopt these changes/additions by Shirley Rodgers and seconded by Debbie Wash. Motion carried.

Lesa Hodge then discussed the issue that affects some of our members that belong to other clubs that have to pay for 2 handicaps thru the KGA/GHIN system. After researching this issue, it was determined and recommended by the KGA and by Lesa that these members would have to continue to pay fees at both clubs until the KGA gets the proper software that can accommodate and resolve this issue which they hope to have ready for the 2016 season.

The Tournament Chair, Donna McNeil gave her report about the upcoming season/schedule. Handouts were offered to our members with all the tournament information. All divisions will have their own Chip in pot and skins game. The Juniper Cup will be offered again this season, volunteer only basis. The first event is April 25, 2015 "What's the Point" and will be held prior to teams being formed. All members were encouraged to join. The drawing of the teams (May 1) will be done differently this season, with lists made of ladies that frequently participate picked first, then on to others with lessor attendance records with the expectations that the teams are more evenly chosen. Donna is planning to hold Match Play in June for the JHLGC members but after the pairings are made, it will be up to the ladies to schedule their own matches.

Sue Wood, Handicap Chair, gave a brief report and asked that all members turn in ANY score when they play. Also, if there are any errors when a member enters a score, Sue will change that if you contact her. The

deadline for acquiring handicaps for the season is March 31st. Members were asked to join before this deadline in order to stay current in the system.

NEW BUSINESS

Members were informed of the purchase of a new CPU unit which was voted for in the fall meeting on October 7th, 2014. \$500 was allotted for this purchase, which was exceeded by \$76 because it was decided that a 2 year warranty should be purchased to protect this purchase in the event of failure. A printer was also authorized to be purchased but since the CPU ran more than expected, Michele Brown and Barbara Reynolds decided it was best to discuss the printer purchase at the spring meeting. The discussion about the printer was do we need a 3 in one (print, scan, fax) printer at a higher cost or will a lessor model be sufficient. It was motioned by Shirley Rodgers that we purchase a new printer for no more than \$100, seconded by Pam Rhodes. Motion carried.

Aggie then brought up our weekly newsletter since Teresa Prather is no longer handling this duty, she asked our members if anyone would like to take this job. Gina Vaile-Nelson very graciously accepted this duty. Teresa will transfer all her information about the newsletter to Gina.

And as we do every spring, it was motioned by Debbie Wash that \$200 be transferred to the Tournament checking account as their startup money for the 2015 season. Seconded by Michele Brown. Motion carried.

There being no more New Business/Miscellaneous, Trina Rhoads motioned that the spring 2015 meeting be adjourned. Debbie Wash seconded. Meeting adjourned.
