SPRING MEETING

March 8, 2016

The Juniper Hill Ladies Golf Club met on Tuesday, March 8, 2016. Thirty-two (32) members were in attendance.

The meeting was called to order by Co-Chair Ruth Hinkle at 6:05 pm.

OLD BUSINESS

A copy of the Fall meeting minutes were distributed to the ladies in attendance. Ruth asked that the minutes from the Fall meeting held on October 17, 2015 be read and approved. A motion was made by Donna McNeil that the minutes not be read but accepted. PJ Johnson seconded and motion was carried.

A copy of the Treasurer's report was also available for all members. Ruth asked that the report read. Glenda Abrams motioned that the treasurer's report not be read and accepted. Motion was seconded by Barbara Terrell. Motion was carried.

Teresa Prather brought up purchasing a sign that was previously discussed at the 2015 fall meeting. Sign would have say Ladies League starting soon with phone numbers and website info. 3 X 6 price was \$42 and 4 X 8 \$60. Location and hanging of this sign would be left at our grounds keeper discretion. Aggie Hampton suggested that up to \$100 be allotted for this sign and also motioned that we purchase the sign. Barbara Terrell seconded. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

At this time, Kirk Schooley, Juniper Hill PGA Professional, addressed the meeting. He told us that the newly renovated/expanded #5 green would be opening soon. He discussed the upcoming clinics in April which will start Tuesday April 19th at Lakeview around 5:00ish, April 21th at Juniper and will continue for 3 weeks on that Tues/Thurs rotation. Kirk also discussed the 13 and under Hill Raisers, practice would be starting soon and all beginners are welcome (no experience necessary). And he was anticipating that the Wildcat tees would soon be HDCP rated. Kirk asked that if anyone would like to help with this program, their assistance would be very much appreciated.

Again at this meeting, we discussed the issue that affects some of our members that belong to other clubs that have to pay for 2 handicaps thru the KGA/GHIN system. After discussing this issue with Patsy Fitzpatrick from the KGA, it was determined that the members would have to continue to pay fees at both clubs until the KGA gets the proper software that can accommodate and resolve this issue. This was supposed to happen for the 2016 season but did not, hoping to get resolved for the 2017 season.

Sue Wood, HDCP chair, reported that starting in April, ladies would be able to enter their scores in the GHIN system. If you enter an incorrect score, you should contact Sue and she will correct.

The Tournament Chair, Donna McNeil gave her report about the upcoming season/schedule. She emailed our members with all the tournament information for the 2016 season. There are 11 events scheduled for the upcoming season. The Ladies Club Championship is scheduled for August 13-14. The Juniper Cup will be offered again this season, volunteer only basis. The drawing of the teams will be done like last season, with lists made of ladies that frequently participate picked first, then on to others with lessor attendance records with the expectations that the teams are more evenly chosen. A couples tournament (last year Tarzan and Jane) this season will be titled Classic, is scheduled for September 17-18. The JHGA is expected to give the JHLGA their annual donation of \$1,000 to go towards the LCC.

There being no more New Business/Miscellaneous, Glenda Abrams motioned that the spring 2016 meeting be adjourned. Debbie Wash seconded. Meeting adjourned.
