Spring Meeting
March 12, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Co-Chairs Barb Reynolds and Sue Wood at 5:30 PM. Officers present were Barb Reynolds, Sue Wood, Glenda Abrams, Elizabeth Coleman, and Charlotte Pyles.

A copy of the fall meeting minutes and treasurer's report were emailed to the Club members for review. Sue Wood asked that these minutes be approved and the members present voted to approve the minutes from October 3, 2018. The Treasurers report from 2018 was also approved by the members. The balance in the account was \$1596.07 as of the end of 2018.

The Club, Wednesday Ladies, and Late Swingers leagues treasurer's reports have been audited by Kim Wooldridge and were found to be in good shape.

Due to new golfing rules for 2019, Lisa Goins and Kirk Schooley have addressed those new issues in our playing rules and the listing of new rules will be sent out as soon as possible.

Kirk Schooley, Juniper Hill Pro welcomed the Club for the new season of golfing. He stated that he would be holding Clinics in April and would get that information out beforehand. Adam Curry, the grounds keeper was in attendance and said that the course would be ready when we started our leagues.

Tournament Chairs, Glenda Abrams and Elizabeth Coleman, presented the list of Club tournaments for 2019. The Tournament account has a total of \$389.28. The Club will give the Tournament Committee \$200 from Club monies to begin the season. The chairs stated that last year, golfers with handicaps of 40+ had to play Wildcat Tees for tournaments. Discussion was held as to whether it would be that way this year but no consensus was reached and no vote was taken.

Handicap Committee, Charlotte Pyles, asked that everyone try to have their handicap paid to the Club by March 28 so that the GHIN system can be updated before the deadline on April 1.

A Rules Seminar will be conducted by Lisa Goins on March 26 at 6:30.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

Addendum: On July 26, 2019, the Tournament Committee asked for an additional \$200 from the Club Account. An email voted was held and the resulting vote was in favor of the transfer of funds.
