

**Juniper Hill Ladies Golf Club

Spring Meeting
March 10, 2020**

The meeting was called to order by Co-Chairs Ruth Hinkle and Teresa Prather at 5:35 pm. Officers present were Teresa Prather, Glenda Abrams, Charlotte Pyles, and Ruth Hinkle. Jenny Bannister and Stacey McClellan were unable to attend. Thirty-eight ladies were in attendance.

Teresa Prather presented Pro Kirk Schooley with a gift certificate for \$100 to Thai Smile in appreciation for all he does for the Juniper Hill Ladies Club.

Ruth Hinkle reported that paper products had been purchased by Donna McNeil and they are stored in the bathroom closet for use by both leagues and the club.

A copy of the fall meeting minutes and treasurer's report were available to the members for review. The minutes from October 5, 2019 were approved by consensus. The Treasurer's report from 2019 was also approved by consensus. The balance in the account was \$1,662.21 as of the end of February 8, 2020.

Donna McNeil was unable to attend the meeting to give the 2019 audit report for the club general fund and the Tournament Committee. These will be presented at a later date.

Glenda Abrams, tournament co-chair, gave a report on the tournament committee. She did not ask for startup funds because the tournament committee has \$872.99 in their account. She reported that the tournament committee has already met to discuss the tournaments for 2020 and there were copies of tournament dates available and also on the website. Glenda also asked that anyone interested in volunteering to please let her know.

Charlotte Pyles, handicap chair and Pro Kirk Schooley spoke in length about the upcoming changes in the GHIN system for 2020. As of 2020 the World Handicap System will be used to establish handicaps. Char said it is important to try to enter your score on the same day you play if at all possible. It now only takes 54 holes to establish a handicap and only 8 of the 20 scores count for handicap purposes. The handicap will change daily, but it was decided to print a handicap roster every Monday for use in league and tournament play.

Lisa Goins will be in charge of the Rules Seminar to be held on Thursday, March 26th, at 6:30 pm.

Pro Kirk Schooley will be conducting golf clinics Thursday, April 16th, 23rd and 30th at 5:30ish; Friday, April 17th, 24th and May 1st at 5:30ish; Saturday, April 18th, 25th and May 2nd. He also plans on playing 'beat the pro' with both leagues one time this summer.

The Rules document was presented and Ruth and Teresa discussed the changes. The Rules document did not require a second as it came from a committee. It passed unanimously by voice vote.

The JHLGC By-laws changes were presented by Ruth Hinkle and did not require a second as they came from a committee. They were passed unanimously by voice vote.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:50 pm.
