

Juniper Hill Ladies Golf Club Spring Meeting March 9, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Co-Chair Teresa Prather at 5:37 pm. Officers present were Co-Chair Teresa Prather (Late Swingers League Administrator), Co-Chair Ruth Hinkle (Wednesday Ladies Day League), Tournament Chair Donna McNeil, and Handicap Chair Glenda Abrams. Jenny Bannister was unable to attend. The meeting was held virtually using the Zoom platform with 27 in attendance including Kirk Schooley, Juniper Hill Golf Professional.

Co-chair Teresa Prather explained that with COVID pandemic restrictions on large gatherings being in force, the JHLGC did not meet during the Fall of 2020 and business from the Spring 2020 meeting was not reviewed. Therefore, a copy of the March 10, 2020 minutes, the Fall 2020 meeting minutes, and the 2020 treasurer's report were distributed by email to all members prior to this meeting for their review. Glenda Abrams made a motion to approve the March 10, 2020 minutes, which was seconded by Aggie Hampton. The minutes from March 10, 2020 were approved by consensus. The Aggie Hampton made a motion to approve the Fall 2020 minutes, which was seconded by Glenda Abrams. The Fall 2020 minutes were approved by consensus. The Treasurer's report from 2020 was also accepted by consensus. The balance in the account was \$1,631.40 as of December 31, 2020.

Donna McNeil audited the JHLGC account for 2019 and 2020 and reported that there were no irregularities in the account.

Donna McNeil, Tournament Chair, gave a report on the tournament committee. She did not ask for startup funds because there was no activity in 2020 and the account has a balance of \$872.99. The 2021 Calendar/Tournament Schedule was emailed to JHLGC members earlier today for their review. Eight JHLGC events have been scheduled as one-day tournaments. The format for each event is subject to change but is anticipated that players will be able to post scores for each event. A sign-up sheet will be posted in a notebook at Juniper for all events. Please enter your team, and tee times when available. Most events are allowing the groups to form their own playing foursome and to make their own tee times. Chip-in pots will be provided for all events for players to participate on a voluntary basis. The Women's Member-Member is scheduled for June 12 as a one day event (\$10 entry fee). Kirk Schooley will be advising the Tournament Committee on formatting details. Two events (Memorial Day and July 4th) may be adjusted to allow participants to play on either of the two days for their scores to count for the tournament because of the availability of carts at Juniper Hill. The Ladies Club Championship is scheduled for Saturday, August 7. The September 18th tournament will be a team event. Donna asked for suggestions for holding this event to be sent by email or phone. Aggie Hampton volunteered to be a member of the Tournament Committee.

Donna McNeil also reported on other events that may be of interest to the Club. Kirk Schooley has tentatively scheduled a Frankfort Junior City Championship on Friday, July 9th, and the Frankfort City Championship for July 10-11. More details will be forthcoming. Juniper Hill will be hosting a tournament for the members of the Women's Central Kentucky on Tuesday, May 11th. Their

organization meeting is scheduled for March 27th. Debbie Wash was unable to attend this tonight but is the Club's representative. If she is unable to attend the meeting Barbara Reynolds and Donna McNeil may be attending as her proxy. More information to be emailed as soon as it is available.

Glenda Abrams, Handicap Chair reminded the Club to fully enter all information onto their membership forms and preferably by the end of March. The KGA and GHIN system is completely digital. Anyone that has not paid by that date will be inactivated in the handicap system. It will take a couple of weeks for the handicap to reappear if it must be reactivated. The forms can be left in a folder at the Juniper Pro Shop or mailed directly to the Treasurer, Jenny Bannister (address on the form). Ruth Hinkle reminded the members to write 'WILDCAT' on the top of the membership form if the players intended to play from the forward tees.

Amy Sneed is a new player and stated that she did not have a handicap at this time but had one in the past. Amy was welcomed to the Club. The club also welcomed Christy Campbell and Ruth Hinkle will be contacting Christy soon to discuss the Club and Leagues.

Pro Kirk Schooley was on the meeting but had technical difficulties. Charlotte Pyles relayed that Kirk was happy to see everyone and is looking forward to the golf season. He anticipates having ladies golf clinics starting sometime the end of March or the first week in April. Information will be posted on Facebook.

There being no further business, Norma Wigglesworth made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Glenda Abrams. The meeting was adjourned at 6:06 pm.
